PERSONAL RIGHTS**Child Care Centers**

Personal Rights, See Section 101223 for waiver conditions applicable to Child Care Centers.

Child Care Centers. Each child receiving services from a Child Care Center shall have rights which include, but are not limited to, the following:

To be accorded dignity in his/her personal relationships with staff and other persons.

To be accorded safe, healthful and comfortable accommodations, furnishings and equipment to meet his/her needs.

To be free from corporal or unusual punishment, infliction of pain, humiliation, intimidation, ridicule, coercion, threat, mental abuse, or other actions of a punitive nature, including but not limited to: interference with daily living functions, including eating, sleeping, or toileting; or withholding of shelter, clothing, medication or aids to physical functioning.

To be informed, and to have his/her authorized representative, if any, informed by the licensee of the provisions of law regarding complaints including, but not limited to, the address and telephone number of the complaint receiving unit of the licensing agency and of information regarding confidentiality.

To be free to attend religious services or activities of his/her choice and to have visits from the spiritual advisor of his/her choice. Attendance at religious services, either in or outside the facility, shall be on a completely voluntary basis. In Child Care Centers, decisions concerning attendance at religious services or visits from spiritual advisors shall be made by the parent(s), or guardian(s) of the child.

Not to be locked in any room, building, or facility premises by day or night.

Not to be placed in any restraining device, except a supportive restraint approved in advance by the licensing agency.

CHILD CARE CENTER NOTIFICATION OF

PARENTS' RIGHTS

As a Parent/Authorized Representative, you have the right to:

Enter and inspect the child care center without advance notice whenever children are in care.

File a complaint against the licensee with the licensing office and review the licensee's public file kept by the licensing office.

Review, at the child care center, reports of licensing visits and substantiated complaints against the licensee made during the last three years.

Complain to the licensing office and inspect the child care center without discrimination or retaliation against you or your child.

Request in writing that a parent not be allowed to visit your child or take your child from the child care center, provided you have shown a certified copy of a court order.

Receive from the licensee the name, address and telephone number of the local licensing office. Licensing Office Name:

Be informed by the licensee, upon request, of the name and type of association to the child care center for any adult who has been granted a criminal record exemption, and that the name of the person may also be obtained by contacting the local licensing office.

Receive, from the licensee, the Caregiver Background Check Process form.

NOTE: CALIFORNIA STATE LAW PROVIDES THAT THE LICENSEE MAY DENY ACCESS TO THE CHILD CARE CENTER TO A PARENT/AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IF THE BEHAVIOR OF THE PARENT/AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE POSES A RISK TO CHILDREN IN CARE.

HOLLISTER PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL COVID -19 / ILLNESS /INJURY WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration for enrollment at HOLLISTER PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL I, on behalf of myself and any minor child/children for whom I have the capacity to contract, hereby acknowledge and agree to the following:

I understand the hazards of the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") and am familiar with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") guidelines regarding COVID-19. I acknowledge and understand that the circumstances regarding COVID-19 are changing from day to day and that, accordingly, the CDC guidelines are regularly modified and updated and I accept full responsibility for familiarizing myself with the most recent updates. I also, understand the hazards of contagious illness not limited to COVID

I understand that accidents at school leading to injuries may occur and am aware of the risk.

3. Notwithstanding the risks associated with COVID-19, the flu and any other contagious illness as well as injury which I readily acknowledge, I hereby willingly choose to ENROLL MY CHILD IN HOLLISTER PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL (summer camp and or preschool program)

4. I acknowledge and fully assume the risk of illness or death related to COVID-19, other contagious illnesses & injuries arising from my being on the premises and participating in PRESCHOOL and hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE (on behalf of myself and any minor children from whom I have the capacity contract) HOLLISTER PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL and / or CHRIST FELLOWSHIP CHURCH their owners, officers, directors, agents, employees and assigns (the "RELEASEES") from any liability related to illness or injury which might occur as a result myself or my child(Ren) being on the premises and participating in preschool.

5. I shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the RELEASEES from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments, losses or expenses of any nature whatsoever (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees, costs and disbursements, whether of in-house or outside counsel and whether or not an action is brought, on appeal or otherwise), arising from or out of, or relating to, directly or indirectly, the infection of COVID-19 or any other illness or injury.

6. It is my express intent that this Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement shall bind any assigns and representatives, and shall be deemed as a RELEASE, WAIVER, and DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the above-named RELEASEES. This Agreement and the provisions contained herein shall be construed, interpreted and controlled according to the laws of the State of California. I HEREBY KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVE ANY RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL OF ANY DISPUTE ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS WAIVER WAS EXPRESSLY NEGOTIATED AND IS A MATERIAL INDUCEMENT THE PERMISSION GRANTED BY RELEASEES TO BE ON PREMISES AND PARTICIPATE IN PRESCHOOL ACTIVITIES. IN SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, I ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT I have read the foregoing Wavier of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreement, have been made; I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this Agreement for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.

Welcome to Summer Camp 2026. We are so excited to see you! We have so many fun, messy and colorful activities planned for [June 22-26 \(9am-12pm\)](#).

Camp Information:

- Please drop off on the playground. Please sign in at sign in tables located outside of the gate PRIOR to drop off. Please be sure to sign your child in and out daily. FULL signatures and times are required. Drop off is at 9am - early drop off is not permitted. The camp playground is closed until 9am. Please do not leave your child unattended or under the care of other parents. Please plan to pick up immediately at 12pm. Late pickups will incur a \$20.00 fee, plus \$1.00 per minute late charge. Habitual late pickups will be dropped from camp without refund.
- After pick up children may play on the church playground with parent supervision but may not remain on school campus per state licensing. Campus closes promptly at 12:05pm
- Please apply sunblock to your child(ren) before camp. Licensing does not allow staff to apply sunblock on children. No exceptions. We are unable to administer any medication unless an IMS form is completed and signed by a doctor in advance - this includes over the counter and prescription medications including creams, lotions, sunblock etc.
- Please make sure your child(ren) eats a good breakfast before camp. Snack is at 10:30am.
- PLEASE NOTE: Outside snacks are not permitted this year unless a food allergy that cannot be accommodated is present. Please see snack menu for reference.
- Please pack a full water bottle, a towel and extra clothing daily. - PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING. ANY UNLABELED ITEMS WILL REMAIN IN BAGS / NOT BE USED.
- PLEASE NOTE: Backpacks are not permitted, please place all items in a large, clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's full name. At drop off, Ziploc bags are to remain on picnic tables in white gated area. Only water bottles are needed on the playground.
- Please do NOT pack outside toys or money.
- Please dress children for the weather. Plan for warm weather however, a light jacket might be needed in the morning hours. PLEASE LABEL JACKETS
- We will be getting wet and messy daily. We will be playing in mud, sand, paint, water and with fun sensory items such as shaving cream & playdough. We also have fabulous splash pads for the kiddos. Wearing clothing that can get wet and / or stained is best. Children will NOT be permitted to change into bathing suits onsite. Staff is unable to assist children in changing into bathing suits. Children WILL be allowed to get wet in their regular clothing.
- Closed toed shoes are a licensing requirement. Please no flip flops or open toed sandals. Crocs are best. Last year we had many mismatched socks left in lost and found after water play. If you can avoid sending your child in socks that would be best.
- Hats and sunglasses are welcome. Staff is not responsible for lost or misplaced items. PLEASE LABEL THESE ITEMS or they will remain in bags.
- If your child is not feeling well. Please keep them home to ensure the safety of others. Our standard health policies remain in effect for the duration of camp. Any child showing signs of illness will be sent home immediately.
- Payment in full is due at the time of enrollment (no refunds offered for missed days or drops).
